### TELEPHONE

Telephones have taken a very important place in our lives. We can save plenty of time through their use both at home and at work. When we speak on a normal telephone the sounds we make are converted into electric pulses. These pulses are carried from speaker to listener at the speed of light. Thus, we are able to speak to people at distant places on a normal telephone in case there is an electric wire joining our telephone to their telephone. To save a lot of wire, the telephones in one city or town are all connected to a telephone exchange. The exchanges between different cities and towns are then connected by a single cable. The mechanism in the telephone changes these pulses back into the sounds that are heard by the receiver.

Scientists have also developed videophones, which transmit a picture as well as sound. These phones, which are not very common, enable you to see the person to whom you are talking.

The latest modification in telephones is the mobile phones, which have become a thing of common use nowadays. They enable their users to establish contacts wherever they are at anytime provided their cell is properly charged.
